Meet Brenda



My name is Brenda, age 48. First I'd like to tell you a little about myself before God came into my life:

I was addicted to drugs since age 13, a victim of domestic violence for numerous years, and I was also addicted to committing crimes (29 felony convictions), and a victim of rape. That is just the short version. Needless to say, I was a mess and definitely living in darkness. My last arrest I went to Santa Rita Jail on very serious charges in November of 2013. I was crying hysterically when I first got there because my life was so out of control and of course I just knew I was going to prison for a long time. I went to court a few days after my arrest for an arraignment. When I came back that night some ladies from Aglow Prison Ministry were there talking to some of the ladies about God....

For whatever reason I was pulled to them to hear what they were saying (*now* I know it was God calling me). I cried the whole time they were there, but I wasn't ready to commit because I was too busy feeling sorry for myself, but a seed was planted!

I remember as a kid my grandmother would talk to us kids about God and how great He is. She used to pick us up for Sunday school. Then just before my teenage years I joined the choir, but I can't say I knew Him at all. I really just wanted to fit in somewhere. I had felt a hole in me my entire life.

My grandmother fell down some stairs once and broke her arm. She told my dad that Jesus came and fixed her arm the night before and she insisted on going to the hospital to get the cast off. Her arm was totally healed! So I did have some knowledge of the greatness of God.

Thanks to the women of Aglow coming into the jails, I was able to really learn about my Lord and Savior. Because of their love for the Lord Jesus and wanting to bring it to us where we were in such a place, to really hear God through them. If it wasn't for the ladies of Aglow Prison Ministry taking time out of their lives to come to the jail, I don't believe I would have heard God calling me.

One of the greatest days of my life was the day God put these ladies in my life. During one of their visits I turned my life over to God.



God has given me such an awesome new life. I no longer feel that hole. He totally softened the judge and DA's hearts. They wanted to give me nearly 5 years in prison, but in the end, thanks to God, I got one year in County Jail with half and 5 years' probation.

When I got out of jail I didn't want to go back to where I'm from because I knew I would probably go back to using and selling drugs, so I asked God to put me somewhere else. Then 2 days before my release He blessed me with a clean and sober home with awesome people. Faith has shown me that God truly loves me and wants me to have peace and joy in my life. He has healed me from a brain aneurysm.

The ladies from Aglow had told us ladies in jail to contact them upon release and they would not only be there for my adjustment to my new life, but would pay for me to go to one of their Retreats! As soon as I got out I called them and one of the ladies came to see me, she gave me encouragement, and also took me to such a beautiful God filled Retreat.

Women from Aglow have been such a blessing to me and a major asset with my journey following God. Aglow has been there for me through all my trials and tribulations along with all my many blessings.

First I want to thank God for loving me and never giving up on me!! I am so grateful for the ladies coming and helping me discover the most amazing journey of my life with Christ, my Lord and Savior, and the Holy Spirit.

With all my heart, thank you for guiding me to my true love... GOD!
