Testimony by Rhonda Osburn, A follower of Jesus Written 9/1/2003

When I think about the appointed time, You drew me into Your light. My shattered heart and spirit so bruised, Mercy's Love I came to find. For in Your eyes each child is Yours, so precious in Your sight and I believe Your heart so breaks, as we struggle our way to find. My deepest hurt was Your tenderest Love, that brought me the way through that I could offer the sacrifice of my life to You. I love You Father with all my strength, none other could take your place, and of the sorrows of my heart, I lift to You in praise.



I had just completed three years of parole at the time this was written. My journey with God is poetry. He inspires my heart and love. I have never met such unconditional Love in my entire life.

The women of Aglow Prison Ministry have been hand-picked by the Father to carry and give the Love of His Son to those of a broken heart in incarceration.

We are a common people, no different than a neighbor or someone at church. We have the same hurts and challenges as anyone else. What we share is an incredible love for Jesus. This ministry is one of action and dedication to our Lord. It is commitment to what God has entrusted us with and each other.

I have been involved with the Women's Aglow Prison Ministry since September 1999. I met with team members in 1994 while incarcerated. The seed was planted in my heart at that time and through the years God nurtured it with all His Love and many helping hands and hearts from the APM ministry.

I am currently (2016) the Field Coordinator of Greater San Diego Area, but will be moving to Chino, Arizona where God is now calling myself and my husband to. There is an Aglow Lighthouse in the nearby town of Prescott that I have been in contact with. During our conversation, APM was mentioned and "Wow" did it all connect! The person I happened to call is the Aglow President of Prescott, Arizona and they have been praying to start up an APM there in their town! God sees the end from the beginning. We say, "Yes, Lord" and He perfectly brings it together. He is Faithful. We have to trust that no matter how the difficulties will come for we are tried to reveal the True.

What I have been seeing is a convergence of California and Arizona APM. I see increase and enlargement. We know God is forming something new in many of the APM board member's hearts. They, too, are sensing a birth of something new that will expand to reach out in a radical way with maybe new territory for all of us in more ways than one! This is God's ministry and the Lord is moving and we are being moved!

This is a powerful ministry and a very humble one as well. Please pray for all of us that we get the vision right.

A little update, as of now, 10/05/2016 we are praying for the ones God will be sending to be a part of the APM here in Prescott AZ. I know He is moving in the hearts of those He has handpicked and stirring that desire to answer *His call* to, "come." Once we all gather then we pray together as a team for the open doors into the local facilities. God is a God of order and timing, we wait on Him and He waits on us. If God is wooing your heart to join or start an APM ministry He will wait until you come! Believe me, the rewards are far greater than you can imagine. He came to set the captives free!

Our doors are still open as the Lord leads us into these other facilities and meetings, Praise Jesus! Our steps are ordered by Him, through Him, I am willing to go, as He leads.
